2022-2026 Teacher/Occasional Teacher Tentative Central Agreement: Ratification Vote Update

ETFO's [Constitution](#) and [Bylaws](#) state that there shall be no less than a two-week period between the time ETFO teacher and occasional teacher members receive the entire Teacher/Occasional Teacher (T/OT) Tentative Central Agreement and the commencement of the ratification vote on the agreement.

ETFO is finalizing arrangements for the **online ratification vote** on the 2022-2026 T/OT Tentative Central Agreement. Here is the information that ETFO can share at this point about the ratification process:

- On Thursday, November 23, 2023, members received all 2022-2026 Tentative Central Agreement documents.

- Two telephone town hall information meetings for teacher and occasional teacher members will be taking place on **Monday, December 11 (the first meeting from 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm and the second meeting from 8:00 pm to 9:00 pm)**. Members will be invited to attend one town hall meeting based on their local's town hall allocation.
- The online vote to ratify the ETFO 2022-2026 T/OT Tentative Central Agreement begins on **Monday, December 11 at 9:00 pm** (i.e., immediately after the final telephone town hall information meeting). Voting ends on **Friday, December 15 at 8:00 pm**.
- The result of the online ratification vote will be announced on **Friday, December 15 at approximately 9:00 pm**.

(Note: All times listed are Eastern Standard Time).

Detailed information about the ratification vote process will be emailed to members in a CB eNewsletter later this week and posted on the ETFO Collective Bargaining website (etfocb.ca). ETFO sends regular, bargaining-related emails, voicemail messages and texts to our members. If you're not receiving these communications, it's possible that ETFO doesn't have your current contact information on file.

To participate in the December 11 telephone town hall information meetings and the subsequent online ratification vote, you will need to do the following as soon as possible:

1. Update your contact information (i.e., first/last name, address, phone numbers, email address) as soon as possible by emailing [ETFO Member Records](#).
2. Have your ETFO ID Number handy. If you don't know your ETFO ID Number, email Member Records for assistance.

Note: You must be an active teacher or occasional teacher member to participate in the telephone town hall information meetings and the online ratification vote.
